√ THE CHECK LIST: Required Essay and Documentation

- 1. 500-word essay; typewritten and double-spaced.
 - a. Guide to the essay: explain your ideas about giving back to your community. Are you pursuing a career in public service? Why? Describe your ideas and plans to make things better. Was there or is there someone special in your life who values education and taught you the importance of education?
 - b. Include what you are considering as a major and why.
 - c. Attach essay to application form
- 2. Provide a copy of the official <u>proof of acceptance letter</u> to the accredited college/ university the applicant is planning to attend. (Letter must be on college letterhead confirming student's acceptance, listing the student's name). No hand-written names on form letters are acceptable.
- 3. Official Transcript from High School. Does not have to be sealed.
- 4. Financial need is a requirement. Provide proof of financial need by sending only <u>one</u> of the following that confirms Pell eligibility:
 - a. Copy of the FAFSA Confirmation page listing Pell grant eligibility or
 - b. Copy of FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR) listing Pell grant eligibility or
 - c. Copy of the Financial Aid Award letter listing Pell grant eligibility from the college/university student is planning to attend.
- **5.** Two letters of reference (from high school guidance counselors, teachers, principals, members of the clergy, community leaders)

Application and documents must be mailed via postal mail.

Deadline: must be postmarked no later than April 1, 2020
